- Targeted Enforcement Operation. Collaterals lawfully encountered that fit within EO. Briefly reiterate operational issues potentially affecting the Op. Increase in public awareness and scrutiny of Immigration Enforcement. Need to be extra vigilant. Be prepared to be recorded and possibly confronted by activist groups. The composure of our mission is reflected in your attitude, body language and overall presence. Maintain exceptional professionalism in the face of adversity and we take away the substance of any false claims. Safety is paramount, look out for one another.
- Offer quick docket to all NTA cases.
- Discuss daily reporting procedures.
